Thanks for joining us for this week's scavenger hunt!

The plants, critters, and other special items can be found all around the island. To participate, go around and take photos (don't take or disturb anything!) of each of these things.

By **Friday** each week, post your finds to the Block Island Conservancy's Scavenger Hunt Facebook group or send an email to Clair (stover@biconservancy.org) with your finds to get a prize!

- **A male fiddler crab** Small crab, one BIG claw
- **A blue azure butterfly** A small, periwinkle blue butterfly
- **Mouse-eared hawkweed** A yellow-flowered plant that grows close to the ground and has small leaves that look like they're covered in fur (like mouse ears!)
- **A bay scallop shell** Look for a deeply ridged, arced shell
- **Oriental chestnut husk** Watch out for its sharp spikes!
- **A piece of trash off the beach or trail** This is the one thing we do want you to take — please bring it home with you to throw away!

If you get them all (or are an all-star hunter!) you'll get a **super cool patch or sticker** in the mail.
